### ***Essential Criteria:***

- Recognised teacher education qualifications and accredited to teach in NSW schools via NESA.
- Appropriate qualifications and ability to teach Religious Education, up to and including Studies of Religion in Stage 6.
- Awareness and preparedness to embrace Visible Learning principles and approaches.
- An understanding of and ability to apply contemporary learning and teaching methodologies
- Successful teaching experience or pre-service experiences.
- Good knowledge and understanding of the use of technology to support teaching, particularly the use of iPads and laptops.
- The ability to develop and sustain strong, appropriate relationships that support and enhance the charism in the College.

### ***Desirable Criteria:***

- Ability and qualifications to teach other KLA courses.

### ***Other:***

- Permanent full-time position to commence in 2019. *The college reserves the right to offer this position as a temporary one year contract in the first instance for operational reasons.*
- The preferred applicant is required to undertake extracurricular responsibilities as part of the employment arrangements at the college.
- Salary and conditions will be as per the NSW Catholic Independent Schools (Teachers – Model B) Multi-Enterprise Agreement 2017. Preferred candidates are required to provide a current Statement of Service.
