### Enrolment Fees

<b>Enrolment Application Fee</b>	Payable at application time.	\$100.00
<b>Enrolment Acceptance Fee</b>	Payable on acceptance of an offer of a place for your family's first child attending the college.	\$150.00
<b>Enrolment Bond</b>	Payable on acceptance of an offer of a place – payable for each child and refundable once the child has left the college and only after deduction of any fees/charges that are owed at that time.	\$500.00

### Sibling Discount

Applicable when a family has two or more children enrolled at the same time (and the children are enrolled by the same people on all signed enrolment contracts).

Second child	12.50%
Third child	25.00%
Fourth child	50.00%

### Upfront Discount

A discount of either 5% (when no sibling discount is also applicable) or 2.5% (when a sibling discount is also applicable) applies to annual tuition fees when the full fee statement is paid in full and funds are received by the college before the **close of business 15 February 2019**.

### TVET and Wilderness Fees – Elective Subjects

The TVET fee only applies to students who have elected to study a TVET subject. This fee must be paid in full by 31 January 2019.

The Year 11 TVET fee is \$900 per subject. The Year 12 TVET fee is \$800 per subject.

The Wilderness subject charge applies if your child has chosen AND been approved to study this elective subject.

### Payment of Fees

Fees can be paid up front or by direct debit payment as follows:

- 44 weekly direct debit payments commencing on the first Friday of Term 1.
- 10 monthly direct debit payments commencing on 15 February and concluding on 15 November (or the next business day if the 15<sup>th</sup> of any month falls on a weekend or a public holiday).
