Your Home Room Family

Home room is where your child starts every day. It is based on a family support structure and consists of students from Year 7-12 in the same house. This is referred to as a vertical home room structure.



Home Room Teachers

They are like your child's 'parent on campus' and work with the Stage Coordinators to be across all aspects, academic and wellbeing, of your child's education.



Senior Leaders

Senior Leaders are students in Year 12 who are the 'elders' in each home room and support the younger students.



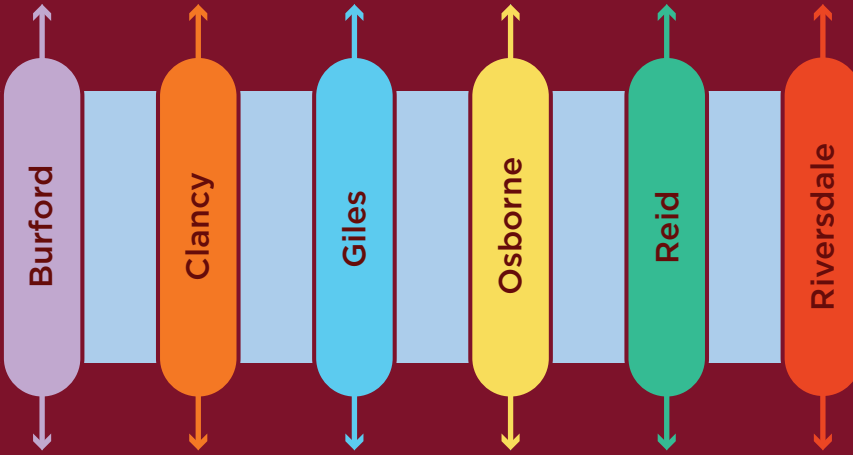
Buddy Leaders
